- Quantity Surveyors Cost Assessment £330-350K
- Need for Sale of original Village Hall Site



The Journey – Part 3

- Tender Submissions (Only 3 out of 5 applied)
- Selection of Best Bid (Godfrey and Hicks only realistic offer) £339K



The Build

- Started 24 Apr 17
- Completed 30 Nov 17 on time and on budget (less extra costs agreed by us)
- Main Hall 14 x 8.5m, Kitchen, Toilet, 3 x Stores

ECDC FIG

- ECDC supportive all the way through from project concept in 2013; advised us to apply for a FIG up to £10K.
- Grant is for non-structural (M&E / finishings)
- Simple application and easy to complete.
 - Must identify how you conduct consultation process
 - How you identify the need



ECDC FIG (Cont'd)

- Very quick turnaround for decision (<4 weeks)
- Very flexible because had to delay 12 months
- Brief summary of project on completion
- Grant rec'd on completion.
- Overall a clear, easy process.
