



Assisted Waste Collection Request

Check if you qualify for the service

Assisted collections are provided where householders are unable to carry their waste sacks or move their wheeled bins to the kerbside, due to infirmity, serious long-term illness or disability. The service is only provided where there is no able-bodied person living at the address.

Proof is required in the form of:

- a medical certificate, which can be obtained from your doctor
- a letter from a carer (this may be a healthcare professional, or someone who regularly visits to care for you at your home)
- a blue badge

All evidence received will only be used to confirm that the assisted collection is required and treated as private and confidential. Once your request has been approved, originals will be returned to you and other documentation securely destroyed. Copies of proof are preferred.

Assisted collection service

Your bins or sacks can be left for collection at an agreed location on your property and will not need to be carried to the property boundary.

You should specify below where bins/sacks will be left for collection.

Please note, assisted waste collections of standard bins or sacks (including refuse, recycling and organic waste) should be clearly visible on the side of the property, closest to the main road access and must not be within a structure such as a shed or behind fences. Sacks must not be left for collection in a container.

Our crews cannot pull bins on long drives or on uneven surfaces (unmade ground, grass, gravelled path) as it is not a safe way to move them. If an assisted collection is required and is not possible through bins for the above reason, you may be switched to an alternative collection service.
