

Assisted Waste Collection Request

Do you qualify?

Assisted collections are provided where householders are unable to carry waste materials for collection to the property boundary due to infirmity, serious long-term illness or disability. The service is only provided where there is no able-bodied person living at the address.

Please note: proof is required in the form of a medical letter.

What will the service mean to you?

Waste materials can be left for collection at an agreed location on your property and will not need to be carried to the property boundary.

Notes

Assisted waste collections include: refuse, recycling and organic waste collection services.

Your collection should be clearly visible on the side of the property closest to the main road access and must not be within a structure i.e. a shed. Sacks must not be left for collection in a container.

In order to maintain our records, residents in receipt of this service will be contacted by letter on an annual basis to check that the service is still required. Failure to respond will result in the service being withdrawn.
