We will work with three existing Community Leisure Trusts to develop performance improvement plans to support the delivery of a district wide indoor sports facility strategy. The Council will guarantee free car parking in the city and town centre car parks, encouraging more visitors to the district and continuing to help increase the local economy. The Council will complete the feasibility study and funding strategy at Ely and Littleport stations ensuring commuters have sufficient parking. The Council will work with partners to identify potential roundabouts and where appropriate new lanes for improvement to support traffic flow and reduce congestion. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The District has a Local Plan which will ensure the efficient use of land and secures future development which is sustainable and delivers what our communities want to see. Residents and visitors to Soham have a station which supports the local economy, reduces congestion on roads and increases employment opportunities. An improved Station Gateway in Ely will reduce waiting times for visitors and commuters, increase employment opportunities, provide economic growth, improve customer satisfaction levels and encourage more people to visit the district.
