SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT ON DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS

Adoption Statement 14th May 2013

This Adoption Statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) and gives notice that East Cambridgeshire District Council has resolved to formally adopt its Developer Contributions Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 14th May 2013.

The East Cambridgeshire Developer Contributions SPD provides guidance on the District Council's approach to mitigating the impact of development through the use of planning conditions, planning obligations (Section 106 agreements) and Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL). Guidance is provided on the type and nature of planning obligations which may be sought and the basis for any charges. The SPD also provides clarification on the relationship between planning obligations and CIL.

The SPD supports Policy CS7 (Infrastructure), Policy H3 (Affordable Housing) and Policy S4 (Developer contributions) in the East Cambridgeshire District Council Core Strategy Development Plan Document. It is intended to replace the previous version of the document, which was adopted by Full Council in October 2011.
