Further to your information request FOI/EIR 21/22-007 please find your question and our response below.

Request:

I am aware that some of the following information is available via the council's website, however, what is there doesn't cover the whole of the period I'm interested in (January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2020), so under the Freedom of Information Act, could you please provide the following information for the rest of the period.

Please provide information about each funeral arranged by the council between July 1 2020 and December 31 2020, where possible including name, date of birth, date of death, age, cost to the authority, whether next of kin are known, and value of estate.

Response:

All of the information you require can be found on the Open Data page of our website. The Public Health Funerals dataset covers the time period from January 2013 to present. This dataset is updated every quarter and was last updated on the 1st of April 2021.

In respect of those requests that were answered in full or partially and the total refused please take this as notice under FOIA, that we:

- a) Consider the information as exempt from disclosure under the Act;
- b) Claim exempt under sections of the Act:

Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000

- c) State why the exemption applies:

The information requested is accessible to you via other means. The information is included in our Open Data page at www.eastcambs.gov.uk/notices/open-data

Section 21 states the following:

1) Information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant otherwise than under Section 1 is exempt information.

2) For the purposes of subsection (1) –

Information may be reasonably accessible to the applicant even though it is accessible only on payment, and b. Information is to be taken to be reasonably accessible to the applicant if it is information which the public authority or any other person is obliged by or under any enactment to communicate

(Otherwise than by making the information available for inspection) to members of the public on request, whether free of charge or on payment.
