Request:

In each of the last three financial years (18/19) (19/20) and (20/21) please state how much income has been accrued by your local authority from motorists for all types of motoring expenses, with a breakdown for;

- Penalty Charge Notices, and where possible a further breakdown by offence e.g. parking ticket, bus-lane fines, etc
- Parking fees, where possible a further breakdown by offence e.g. parking permits and pay-and-display income, etc

Response:

East Cambridgeshire District Council is only responsible for monitoring their own car parks within the district. We are not responsible for any on-street parking offences or driving offences. The Council run car parks are all free to use (with restrictions), except for 2 Pay & Display commuter car parks.
