Further to your information request FOI/EIR 22/23-164 please find your question and our response below.

Request:

I would like to know the source of the beeping from the large grey metal access point at Soham Station. We presume it is an audible alarm. Regardless of whether it is sounding and when, we would like to know why the alarm is repeatedly functioning and what it is for, ie. the purpose of it and who is responsible for it.

Response:

Despite making enquiries lots of emails to and from Alan Neville of Greater Anglia we have been unable to identify the alarm, obtain an explanation as to why this alarm was intermittently sounding or who is responsible. However, we assume that as Alan Neville has been chasing engineers regarding the alarm, that Greater Anglia must have some responsibility.
