

Regarding the amount of funding that East Cambs has been allocated for 2023-24 and 2024-25 by the government as part of its homelessness prevention grant.

For 2023-24, East Cambs is due to receive £333,106 and for 2024-25, £337,359 in a total allocation of more than £670,000 over these two years.

In 2022-23, East Cambs was allocated £323,632 from the homelessness prevention grant. I'd like to know:

- Why has East Cambs received more homeless prevention gov money than in 2022-23?
- How will the latest round of funding be used in short and long-term?
- Are the 2023-24 and 2024-25 allocations the highest amounts ECDC has ever received for tackling homelessness and if not, what are the highest sums?
- How many people in East Cambs are currently classified as homeless?
- What aims does ECDC have in tackling homelessness in the district and how will the council achieve these aims?
