Further to your information request FOI/EIR 22/23-349 please find your question and our response below.

Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, please may I have a redacted copy (i.e. one which does not contain names, addresses or other information likely to lead to a person on the register being identified) of the latest copy of your Potentially Violent Persons Register aka Restricted Persons Register aka Cautionary Register aka whatever relevant name you know such a register by. In order to avoid any further confusion, let me make clear that my FOI request is for copies of redacted copies of the register which only state the reasons why an individual was added to the blacklist, the categorisation of risk attached to that (e.g. low, medium, high), and how long they were placed on the list for.

I am writing to request publication of any blacklists which the council may operate.

This would include (but not exclusive to)

- serial complainers
- violent/aggressive/abusive persons
- troublemakers
- campaigners/activists

I would also request information on the distribution/circulation of these lists.
