- The address/ postcode where the request was made

I'm looking for the number of dropped kerbs which create access to a property. I believe this would be planning permission in this case.

It provides the planning outcome and also any appeal decision, I include a list of meanings below:

PDE – Pending Decision
PER - Permitted
PR – Permitted Retrospective
REF – Refused
WDN – Withdrawn
