Further to your information request FOI/EIR 22/23-409, please find your question and our response below.

Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 I request the following information.

1. What is going to be implemented within Ely and surrounding areas as far as "Low Traffic Neighbourhoods" are concerned?
2. What are ECDC's plans as far as the "15/20-minute city" global initiative that is currently rolling out in Oxford, Canterbury and many other towns/cities around Britain despite huge censorship and when are they due to be implemented?
3. When was/is the referendum being held for the people of Ely to put their views across as far as LTN and 15/20-minute city initiative proposals?
4. If no referendum has taken place and one is not planned, who is personally claiming the right to give consent on behalf of the people of Ely?
5. Who should people hold accountable for the restrictions which will come about once any initiatives are put in place and from whom can they claim remedy for the tort?

Response:
