## **Request:**

These questions relate to new homes built by the council. 1) In the 2022/23 financial year (1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023) how many new homes of any tenure did the council complete? The Council does not own, build or manage housing stock

1) a) Please can you provide a breakdown of those new build completions, by tenure (for example, how

many were social rent, shared ownership, market sale, temporary accommodation, etc). The Council does not own, build or manage housing stock

2) If the council has a council-owned housing company, in the 2022/23 financial year (1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023) how many new homes of any tenure did the company complete?
East Cambs Trading Company (ECTC) is a company wholly owned by the Council.
