

Further to your information request FOI/EIR 23/24-492, please find your question and our response below.

## Request:

Please provide your total spend on communications and public relations for the last three financial year's (20/21,21/22,22/23). For each year I would like a breakdown containing the following information:

- Spend on communications and public relations activities.
- Total number of communications and public relations employees.
- Total salary cost for all communications and public relations employees

## Response:

- 20/21 £54,789 21/22 - £76,396 22/23 - £86,411

- This information is withheld under Section 40(1) Personal Information. As there are only 2 members of staff who work in communications and public relations, we feel that providing the total salary cost would be providing their personal data.

- a) Consider the information as exempt from disclosure under the Act;
- b) Claim exempt under sections of the Act:

## Section 40 (1) – Personal Information (ABSOLUTE)

- c) State why the exemption applies:
- (1) Any information to which a request for information relates is exempt information if it constitutes personal data of which the applicant is the data subject.
- (2) Any information to which a request for information relates is also exempt information if—
- a) it constitutes personal data which does not fall within subsection (1)

As Section 40 is an Absolute exemption, it does not involve a public interest test.
