




Cambridgeshire City, District and County Councils have secured grant funding for lower income households in Cambridgeshire to improve energy efficiency, save money on their heating bills and cut carbon. Funding is available for homes with:

- an Energy Performance Certificate rating of E, F or G; and
- a household income that doesn't exceed £30,000 per annum; or



Not energy efficient - higher running costs

• a household in receipt of means-tested benefits

Our partner Aran Group can check your Energy Performance Certificate rating.

The scheme will take a "fabric first" approach, focussing on improving insulation standards first and can deliver energy saving measures such as:

- Cavity wall insulation
- Solid wall insulation
- Heat Pumps
- Draught-proofing
- Loft Insulation
- Solar PV

The grant (up to £25,000) can cover 100% of the costs of upgrading owner occupied homes and two thirds of the costs of upgrading privately rented homes, with the landlord contributing the balance. Maximum grant available depends on the home's current Energy Performance Certificate band, fuel type and ownership.

The Council is working with Aran Group to assess eligibility of homes, identify suitable upgrades and install these upgrades.
