

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary election

For the Ely and East Cambridgeshire constituency

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve the Ely and East Cambridgeshire constituency.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the offices of the (Acting) Returning Officer, East Cambridgeshire District Council, The Grange, Nutholt Lane, Ely, Cambs, CB7 4EE.
3. Nominations papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on 7 June 2024.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as banker in the United Kingdom.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on 4 July 2024.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on 18 June 2024.
7. New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm. on 19 June 2024.
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on 26 June 2024.

9. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on 26 June 2024.
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on 4 July 2024.
