Public Notice of Consultation on the Replacement Sutton Neighbourhood Development Plan -Regulation 16 – The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (As Amended)

On 10 December 2023, Sutton Parish Council formally submitted its draft replacement Neighbourhood Plan to East Cambridgeshire District Council (ECDC) for independent examination, which also includes a final round of public consultation. The draft plan sets out a vision for the future of Sutton Parish and planning policies that will be used to determine planning applications locally (within the Sutton Neighbourhood Area).

The Parish Council has confirmed that the submitted draft Neighbourhood Plan will, if finalised, replace the current Sutton Neighbourhood Plan of 2019.

In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012 (as amended), East Cambridgeshire District Council is inviting comments on the draft replacement Sutton Neighbourhood Plan and associated documents for just over six weeks. The consultation will take place from **Tuesday 2** January to Wednesday 14 February 2024.

The consultation is open to anyone to submit their representations.

The draft replacement Sutton Neighbourhood Plan and accompanying submission documents are available to download from the Document Library on the Sutton Neighbourhood Plan page on our website at https://www.eastcambs.gov.uk/local-development-framework/sutton-neighbourhood-plan. A paper copy of the draft replacement Sutton Neighbourhood Plan is available for inspection at East Cambridgeshire District Council's customer service centre during normal opening times.
