Volunteer requirements and Volunteering Sustainability

Volunteer drivers are required. Outreach is conducted with GP surgeries and their Practice managers. Historically there have been some difficulties in outreach with Parish Councils in terms of their responsiveness.

It would be helpful to establish a link for VCAEC off Parish Council websites.

Currently VCAEC receives funding from:

- Cambridgeshire County Council
- East Cambridgeshire District Council
- Clinical Commissioning Group fund

It is uncertain what this position will look like in 5 years time.

There is a need to build sustainability into the programmes to make them less reliant on funding from Public Sector organisations.

- VCAEC aims to recruit a database of 100 volunteers
- Aims to ensure commitment at least three times per year on part of each volunteer.
