What works well and what would you like to see improved?

Good signage prevents problems (e.g. early notification of restricted access for HGVs at New Cheveley Road Railway Bridge)

Parish/Police/Highways working together

Secure street furniture

Joint funding (County/parish) for highways improvements works

Improvements need to be made to funding arrangements for design/survey work in relation to highways improvements

Innovative solutions to parking problems (e.g. using field opposite Littleport Community Primary School)
