Dear Sirs

As a representative for the Responsible Authority in regard to health and safety I would like to raise an objection to the licence application submitted by Mr Janes for the proposed Traditional German Food and Beer Festival to be held on Saturday 17th October at Dullingham Polo Club.

The Council have not been approached about this event and we have not seen a risk assessment or an Event Management Plan that would explain how the festival was to run given the current restrictions due to the Covid-19 virus. The event application is for 499 people with no information provided as to how they may be safely accommodated on the site, and sufficiently distanced whilst enjoying the food, drink, and any entertainment.

Given that the application was received on Thursday 1st October I feel I must lodge this objection now to meet the timescales of the legislation but invite the applicant to make contact me at the earliest opportunity should they believe they have both a comprehensive risk assessment and Event Management plan in place.
