1.0 ISSUE

- 1.1 To receive a presentation on the development of options for the Burwell Masterplan.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION(S)

3.0 THE REPORT

- 3.1 Huntingdonshire District Council's Urban Design Team were engaged to review the data which had been collected about Burwell from the desk top research and the issues stage public consultation, and to develop ideas about the options for the future development of the village. They will give a presentation on these ideas at the meeting for discussion by the Working Party.
- 3.2 The Working Party will be asked whether they consider the proposals satisfactory for wider public consultation purposes, or whether they wish for further work to be carried out.
- 3.3 Officers will also be presenting the emerging options to Burwell Parish Council at their meeting on 13th December 2011 to obtain their comments on the proposals.

- 4.1 The costs of the options development work will be met from existing budgets.
- 4.2 An Equality Impact Assessment (INRA) will need to be carried out on the final Burwell Masterplan document.
