1.0 ISSUE

1.1 To note the action taken on the grounds of urgency by the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Chairman of the Committee, in compliance with Part 3 of the Council's Constitution, under section 5.1 of the Community & Environment Committee's Terms of Reference, of the allocation of Section 106 monies to ensure the timely delivery of a new play park roundabout in Pymoor.

3.2 Therefore, under delegated authority, a decision was made to allocate Section 106 money for this project to ensure it was not delayed.
