Reason for call-in	<p>The decision to close public conveniences at Newnham Street and Sacrists Gate was taken without adequately considering or responding to the observations of the Access Group, who were approached for comments only after the original recommendation to Commercial Services Committee had been made by the Asset Development Committee. The decision to close these conveniences disproportionately affects users of disabled facilities, as both toilets to be closed are disabled accessible.</p> <p>Furthermore, it is not evident that everything that could have been done has been done to seek alternative ways of keeping the facilities open or providing different options in consultation with the Cathedral, City of Ely Council, local businesses, and others.</p>
