1.0 ISSUE

1.1 To receive details of the revised political balance of the Council and the implications for the allocation of seats on Committees arising from the result of the Soham South By-Election on 19 June 2014.

2.0 <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

2.1 That Council:

- (a) Notes the details of the revised political balance of the Council as set out in Appendix 1 and approves the allocation of seats on Committees, etc.
- (b) Allocates Members to the vacancies set out in paragraph 3.2.2 of this report, or makes other changes to the membership of Committees, Sub-Committees in accordance with the Proportionality calculations.

3.0 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Following the death of Independent Councillor John Palmer, a By-Election was held for the vacancy in the Soham South District Ward on 19 June 2014 and Councillor Hamish Ross was elected. Councillor Ross has given notification that he wishes to join the Conservative Group. Attached at Appendix 1 is a table showing the revised allocation of places on Committees, Sub-Committees and other Member Bodies in accordance with the requirements of the Proportionality rules.
- 3.2 Group Leaders have been advised of the number of places available on each Committee to be filled by their Groups, and of any necessary adjustments to be made between the political Groups in their overall seat allocations. The resulting changes can be summarised as follows:
 - 3.2.1 When proportionality was calculated for the Annual Council meeting on 15 May 2014, the vacancy due to the death of Cllr Palmer had to be included in the calculation and this was nominally allocated places on Commercial Services and Licensing Committees as a result of discussions between the Group Leaders. The Liberal Democrat Group ceded one place on Licensing Committee to the vacancy; the Conservative Group gained one place on Licensing Committee and

- one place on Planning Committee; and the Independent Group gained one place on Regulatory and Support Services Committee and one place on Corporate Governance and Finance Committee.
- 3.2.2 However, under the revised proportionality calculations at Appendix 1, the Independent Group need to gain one place from the Conservative Group and one place from the Liberal Democrat Group. Since the Conservative Group and Liberal Democrat Group cannot both cede a place on Licensing Committee to the Independent Group, probably the most pragmatic option would be for the Liberal Democrat Group to cede a place on Licensing Committee to the Independent Group and for the Conservative Group to cede a place on either Corporate Governance and Finance Committee or Regulatory and Support Services Committee to the Independent Group. When compared to the Committee allocations made at the Annual Council meeting, this would give the Conservative Group a new place on Commercial Services Committee and on either Corporate Governance and Finance Committee or Regulatory and Support Services Committee (depending on which one they cede to the Independent Group) and the Independent Group would lose one place on either Corporate Governance and Finance Committee or Regulatory and Support Services Committee (depending on which one they did not gain from the Conservative Group) but would gain a place on Licensing Committee. Attached at Appendix 2 is a copy of the current list of Membership of Committees, Sub-Committees and Other Member Bodies approved at Annual Council on 15 May 2014, to assist Members understanding of the required changes.

4.0 THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND HOUSING ACT 1989

- 4.1 Section 15(5) of the Act sets down the principles for the allocation of seats on Committees between the political Groups on the Council. The principles are applied in sequence and provide a safeguard to enable any distortion caused by rounding up or down to be remedied. The principles require, in effect, that:
 - (a) all seats are not allocated to the same political Group.
 - (b) the majority of seats are allocated to the political Group having a majority of the authority's membership.
 - (c) subject to (a) and (b) above, the number of seats on the TOTAL of all committees allocated to a political Group bears the same proportion as the proportion of the seats held on full Council (this principle allows any accumulated distortion caused by rounding up or down in (d) below to be remedied).
 - (d) subject to (a) to (c) above, the number of seats on each Committee allocated to a political Group bears the same proportion to the proportion on full Council.

- 4.2 The effect of rounding up or down across the overall number of seats to be allocated on Committees can be quite significant which is why the principles explicitly provide for any distortion to be rectified.
