1.	Members of the public are welcome to attend this meeting. If you are visiting The Grang during normal office hours you should report to the main reception desk, where you will a sked to fill in a visitor's pass that must be worn at all times whilst you are in the buildin Please remember to return your pass before you leave.		
	 This will not apply if you come to an evening meeting: in this case you will enter via the real access doors in the glass atrium at the back of the building and a Facilities Assistant will direct you to the room in which the meeting will take place. The maximum capacity for meetings in the Council Chamber has been set by the Fir Officer at 100 persons. Allowing for Member/Officer attendance and room layou constraints, this will normally give a capacity for public attendance of 60 people plu Applicants, Agents, the Press and Registered Speakers. 		
	Admittance to the Council Chamber is on a "first come, first served" basis and public access will be from 30 minutes before the start time of the meeting.		
	There are a number of schemes aimed at encouraging public participation in the Council's activities and meetings. These include public question times and a process to enable petitions to be submitted. Details of these can be obtained by calling any of the telephone numbers below or by logging onto the Council's website.		
2.	Fire instructions for meetings:		
	 If the fire alarm sounds please make your way out of the building by the nearest available exit - i.e. the back staircase or the fire escape in the chamber. Do not to use the lifts. 		
	 The fire assembly point is in the front staff car park by the exit barrier. 		
	 This building has an auto-call system to the fire services, so there is no need for anyone to call the fire services.
