We are writing as neighbours regarding the refurbishment and extension of no 6 Hop Row by Mr & Mrs Amory.

Since purchasing the property Mr Amory has kindly kept us regularly informed of his plans and asked for our views. We are pleased to see the property being modernised and have no objections to the proposed work.

With respect to the removal of the Silver Birch tree which is close to, and, overhangs our property, we welcome the removal of it. The tree is high maintenance for us as a retired couple. It has to be pruned our side every couple of years to stop it damaging our roof, and, our gutters have to be cleared at least twice a year due to blockage with it's leaves and seeds. In the autumn, we have over two months of leaves and seeds covering our side passage to the garage which needs sweeping twice a day (my disabled wife cannot get to our garage to access the tumble drier or freezer as it becomes

slippery and she does not feel safe). If we open doors or windows, the seeds/leaves blow into the house or garage.

This tree is in a similar situation to the Beech tree which was giving us similar problems and you gave permission for it to be removed a few years ago
