Action Plan 'Recycling Matters'

Long term behaviour change

A 12 month action plan to increase the percentage participation in Low performance areas within the East Cambridgshire District Council Recycling Service.

What is meant by a low participation area?

The term LPA is applied to geographic areas where there is a concentration of households which, for whatever reason, participate less in the recycling service(s) provided than households in other areas of the Authority (WRAP)

What is low participation?

Low levels of participation in recycling services overall resulting in low tonnages collected. Incorrect participation resulting in the wrong materials being presented and poor quality of recyclate collected.

Groups of 'low participation' households with similar housing, social or demographic characteristics are often referred to as:

Hard-to-reach groups; Sections of the population with whom it may be difficult to communicate the reason to participate in the service and/or the practicalities of using it.

Hard-to-engage groups. Sections of the population that are 'hard-to-reach' operationally. This may be due to their location or housing type e.g. high rise flats or an isolated rural area.

Scheme method summary

Develop project message 'Why is it important for you to recycle.' Send two leaflets out to targeted areas six months apart. Work with stakeholders within community hubs to re enforce message. Utilise all available media. Carry out post survey after project completed. Review and Evaluate.
