Licensing Act 2003 – Decision Notice Re: Inferno BBQ, 78 Broad Street, Ely, CB7 7BE

Members considered the content of the report, the oral submissions of those present, and the written statement of one resident who was unable to attend. In doing so they noted the concerns of the residents regarding the venue becoming a late night destination for entertainment, alcohol and takeaway food, and their concerns regarding smoking and parking by those using the premises. Members also noted the applicant's reassurances of his intentions, and the concerns of Environmental Health.

Members understood why the application as publicised via the public notices had caused a great deal of concern to those living in close proximity to the premises, but also had to note that the conditions offered and agreed during the licensing process would go a long way to promoting the licensing objectives and dispelling these concerns. However, having fully considered the outstanding representations, Members considered that to allow the premises to cease licensable activities and to close at the proposed times would likely have a detrimental impact on the prevention of public nuisance objective.

Due to this Members have determined to grant the licence subject to the following times and conditions which are considered appropriate and proportionate to the objective being pursued (to uphold the licensing objectives), and in doing so creates a fair balance between the request of the applicant, and the concerns raised by the Responsible Authority and residents.

The licence shall be issued for the following:

In addition, the three conditions put forward by Environmental Health in Table 3 at 3.11 of the Committee report are to be included on the Licence, with the amendment to the third condition to read "The licence holder shall ensure that no new customers enter the premises less than 30 minutes before closing".

The licence shall also be subject to the full Mandatory Conditions contained in the Licensing Act 2003 and the Operating Schedule Conditions set out at Appendix 3 to the official report.

Please note, the Applicant or any persons who submitted a valid representation has a right of appeal against this decision, which should be made within 21 days of notification of the Sub-Committee's decision. Appeals for this type of application are heard at the Magistrates' Court.
