What we can collect?

Materials should be left for collection as shown in the photograph. Please only include items listed, and keep materials separate where shown.

KITCHEN, GARDEN WASTE AND CARDBOARD









Collected in Brown sack

Green garden waste:

Grass & hedge cuttings

- Weeds
- Flowers & plants
- Leaves
- Prunings

Food waste, including:

- Fruit & vegetables
- Meal leftovers, including meat & bones

- Cardboard & shredded paper

Please wrap wet food waste in newspaper.

Please don't include plastic or corn starch bags, even if they say they are biodegradable.

Cardboard can be left flattened and bundled next to brown sacks.

- *A maximum of 4 brown sacks will be replaced each collection.
- *Additional sacks can be purchased from local suppliers, details are available at www.eastcambs.gov.uk or by telephoning 01353 665555.

- Catalogues (please remove cardboard cover)



Collected in carrier bag

Glass bottles & jars (please remove lids)

CANS/TINS & AEROSOLS





Collected in seperate carrier bag

- Food & drinks cans
- Aerosols (don't squash)




Collected in Plastic recycling sack (provided)

New Services from 2013

Using your waste and recycling services

- Collection Point at your property boundary closest to the road access and clearly visible. Where your property is accessed by a private track or road, material must be left for collection where this joins the public highway.
- Collection time Waste must be ready for collection by 7am, but please do not put material out earlier than 6pm on the evening before collection.
- Materials will only be collected if in the correct bin or sack provided to the property. Bin lids must be closed, & bins must not be too heavy to comfortably move.

- Fruit and vegetables
- Egg shells
- Tea bags
- Meal leftovers
- Meat and bones (cooked or uncooked)
- *Please wrap wet food waste in newspaper or paper bags, not plastic or cornstarch bags even if degradable.

- Plastic bags
- Flower pots/trays
- Stones/rubble Soil and turf
- Animal waste
- Poisonous weeds e.g. Japanese Knotweed &
- Ragwort
- Cat litter
- Anything not on the 'Yes Please' list



Refuse (black sacks)

This service is for small items of household waste that cannot be recycled through existing services.


52 black sacks (2 rolls of 26) are delivered once a year to all households. Additional black sacks will be collected, but no further sacks will be provided before the next due distribution date.




Please tie sacks securely to reduce the risk of spillage and wrap sharp items. Do not include hazardous materials such as chemicals or paint. Please take these to Witchford or Milton Recycling Centres (0345 045 5207).

Black sacks containing garden waste will not be collected.

New service performance



We have no problems, only challenges!

- Do nothing & recycling declines
- Rubbish is changing
- East Cambridgeshire commitment to 60% recycling
- EU target of 65% by 2030
- Local government funding reductions
 - Less money
 - Less staff

How can Parish Councils help?

- Encourage residents to:
 - Recycle
 - Increase what they do recycle
 - Only include acceptable materials
- Publicise information provided by ECDC e.g. monthly `It pays to recycle in East Cambridgeshire' winners
- Arrange visits to Amey waste treatment site

How can Parish Councils help?

- Recycling Champions
 - Encourage
 - Explain
- Host presentations on recycling
- Invite Recycling Team to community events
- Direct people to web site & forward enquiries
- Promotion in local schools

- Waste collection & street cleaning services currently provided by Veolia.
- Contract to 31st March 2018
- Extension option until 31st March 2019

What next?

- Review of options:
 - What collection services?
 - Delivered by who?
 - Commercial contract
 - Trading Company
 - Jointly with neighbouring council
 - Should Veolia's contract be extended?
- Aims:
 - weekly waste collections
 - 60% recycling target
 - affordable




Most common issues
